Pat Lehman Legacy Award

The Pat Lehman Legacy Award is an annual award given to a former supervisor who had served for at least 24 years on his or her local conservation district board. Other criteria for favorable consideration:

- Held the office of chairperson
- Regularly attended KACD annual conventions
- Served as chairperson of or served on a KACD committee
- Served an active role in conservation activities at the state and local level
- Demonstrated leadership in promoting conservation in Kansas

The Pat Lehman Legacy Award recipient is selected by KACD executive board vote and will be notified prior to the annual convention (around the first of November). The recipient will be invited to attend the entire convention as KACD's guest.

Recipient of the award will receive:

- Convention registration bundle for award recipient
- Hotel room for Monday night
- Plaque to be presented at the awards banquet Monday night

Nominations will be submitted in a one page narrative form to include an explanation of all criteria that pertains to the nominee. Nominations can be sent to the KACD Area Director or to Dan Meyerhoff, KACD Executive Director at kacd@eaglecom.net by October 12, 2018.
